

STEP 1

RIGHT CLICK ON NOTEBOOK 11 AND PIN TO TASK BAR
OPEN NOTEBOOK FROM THE TASK BAR(it takes along time so be patient)

STEP 2

OPEN ONE OF YOUR KHAN DRAWINGS

WINDOWS KEY (on keyboard between alt and ctrl)

PRINT SCREEN (on keyboard upper right hand corner)

USE WINDOWS- PRINT SCREEN TO CAPTURE WHAT IS ON THE SCREEN

MAKE SURE YOU CAN SEE THE LINES OF CODE THAT SHOW THE THREE DIFFERENT SHAPE
COMMANDS (you might have to take two screen captures to do this)
